We will continue the theme 'Justice Seeking Church' by sharing part of the film **Tinderbox** and then exploring two or three questions arising from what we have seen and heard, the themes for each week are below:

15th April – seeking Justice; actions for a better future (no film)

Tinderbox is a rare and thought-provoking examination of injustice and conflict in Israel and occupied Palestinian territory. There are stories from a wide variety of contemporary voices as well as exploration of how history continues to play out in the daily lives on either side of the divide. This documentary film was released in 2022 and does not reference the events of the 7th October and the current war in Gaza.
