I have usually sent each contributor under the Gift Aid Scheme a letter detailing their contribution; apologies for not being able to do it this year. You will remember that you need to have paid sufficient Income Tax to cover the amount reclaimed from the Inland Revenue– this comes to £25 tax for every £100 you contribute.
