Lent Lunches from 17th February

For Lent 2026 the Worship Group have developed a different approach to Lent.

Lent is traditionally a time of preparation for Easter, and in particular the events of Holy Week. The story of Jesus' journey to the cross is described in each of the gospels, but so too are the stories of some of the people around Jesus and much of the narrative is explaining what they are experiencing. This year we have tried to explore the experiences of some of those around Jesus who witnessed and were involved in different parts of the narrative.

We hope that can lead us to a deeper understanding of Jesus' Passion, but also by looking at different peoples experiences

we can hope to better understand our own faith and how we respond to times when our faith feels to be under stress.

Some of the people we shall be thinking about are the obvious choices, but others may seem to be more in the shadows of the Easter story, but we believe that each individual or group of people has something to say to all of us.

During Lent we shall be holding our Tuesday lunch groups discussing the chosen witness of the previous Sunday in more detail. We shall either be looking at the story of the individual in more depth or at the implications in our lives of their experience. We shall begin on Shrove Tuesday, 17th February, with a discussion about “Learning from the Experiences of Others”. Please register on the sheets in the foyer if you would like to attend.
