We will be having our usual Lent weekly Lunches (soup and a roll) and Discussion starting on **Tuesday 11th March from 12.30pm to 2.00pm, please sign up in the hall if you would like to attend.** We will continue the theme 'Justice Seeking Church' by sharing part of the film **Tinderbox** and then exploring two or three questions arising from what we have seen and heard.

***Tinderbox** is a rare and thought-provoking examination of injustice and conflict in Israel and occupied Palestinian territory. There are stories from a wide variety of contemporary voices as well as exploration of how history continues to play out in the daily lives on either side of the divide. This documentary film was released in 2022 and does not reference the events of the 7th October and the current war in Gaza.*

We are also showing the full film (90 minutes) on Saturday 15th March at 2pm .
